

Mitten Crochet Pattern

Size G hook for small child size

Worsted weight yarn

Every **FIRST** and **LAST** stitch in each row is a regular single crochet. All other stitches use **BACK LOOP ONLY**. Work slip stitches **LOOSELY!**

Chain 69.

Row 1: sc 8, sl st 6, sc 18, sl st 4, Sc 18, sl st 6, sc 8. Chain 1 & turn.

Row 2 – 12 repeat row 1.

At this point, starting from opposite end from working end, count 22 stitches in and place a marker there.

Row 13: Thumb set up row – sc 8, sl st 6, sc 8, chain 15, **skip stitches over to the stitch with the marker**, sc 8, sl st 6 sc 8. Chain 1 & turn.

Row 14, 15, 16: sc 8, sl st 6, sc 14, sl st 3, sc 14, sl st 6, sc 8. Chain 1 & turn.

Do not cut yarn, fold mitten, sc edges together all around including across finger tips and across finger area. Cut yarn and weave in ends.

To make cord: Chain enough stitches to equal approximately 36 inches and slip stitch through the back loops to form a cord approximately 31 inches long and attach to the thumb side of each cuff edge. Weave in yarn ends.

sc – single crochet

sl st – slip stitch
